Poster Session

Contributions to this session (on any neuropsychological topic) are invited and should be submitted via the web site <http://bressanone.dur.ac.uk/> within October 31st, 2006. Abstracts should be 200 to 250 words long and, before the title, the domain should be specified, in capital letters, choosing among the following:

- Language (lexicon)
- Language (syntax)
- Numbers
- Memory
- Executive functions and frontal lobe
- Action and motor control
- Visual processing
- Spatial processing
- Other

The number of accepted posters is limited to 100. Only 48, selected by the committee, will be discussed in detail. Nobody can be first author on more than one poster. A maximum of three posters can be considered from each lab. Each poster should be a maximum of A0 portrait (or 2xA1 landscape, or 4xA2 portrait, or 8xA3 landscape....). Any poster violating this format will be removed.

Symposia for the 2008 meeting

Those who are interested in proposing a symposium for the 2008 meeting should send a proposal to the local organisers within January 21, 2007. Proposals will be cir-

culated to the steering committee. A proposal should indicate the title of the symposium, its motivation and description (no longer than one page), the name of the organiser and a list of three speakers (not from the same institution) who have already agreed to participate.
